\*Vaccines are available when immunizing pharmacist or MinuteClinic® practitioner is on duty, while supplies last. Most vaccines require a prescription (except for the flu shot).

[+Copayment, copay or coinsurance means the amount a participant is required to pay for a prescription in accordance with a Plan, which may be a deductible, a percentage of the prescription price, a fixed amount or other charge, with the balance, if any, paid by a Plan.]

[\*\*The vaccines listed above are generally covered under the Affordable Care Act by non-grandfathered health plans and health plans sold on an Exchange by Qualified Health Plans or QHPs, and typically do not require cost sharing if provided by an in-network provider, consistent with specified dosage limits and satisfaction of age and other vaccine specific requirements. Other restrictions may apply. Check with your health plan if you have any questions about your benefits.]
